INFORMATION CELESTE COLLECTS FROM YOU

You can visit the Celeste website to read product and company information without telling us who you are and without revealing any personally identifiable information. There are instances, however, where Celeste requests personally identifiable information (i.e. name, address, company name, job title, email address, telephone number, fax number, information about how you use our products, financial information, comments, etc.) to provide you a service, such as e-business or correspondence, or to respond to a request for information.

Described below are the ways in which Celeste actively and passively collects information during a website visit. This information is collected and stored in a manner appropriate to the nature of the data by Celeste, Celeste's affiliates and its third-party service providers (i.e. Supplier, distributor, etc.) and is used to fulfil your requests, as further described below.

Active Information Collection

Like many other websites, we actively collect information from our visitors both by asking specific questions on this website and by permitting you to communicate directly with us via online forms and e-mail. Some of the information that you submit may be personally identifiable. Also, if you place an order, you may be required to provide financial information. Celeste does not have control over the privacy policies applied by any other party that you may disclose information to. If you would like information on any other party's privacy policy, you should contact that party directly, and we encourage you to do so.

If you register with this website in order to gain access to certain site features, during the registration process we may ask for your first and last name, e-mail address, telephone number, company name and postal address, all of which are generally required in order to complete the registration. We also may ask you for other optional information, such as your experience with Celeste products. Registered users who provide this information and register can benefit from access to additional information about Celeste products and other features that Celeste may offer from time to time.

Passive Information Collection

As you navigate through a website, certain information can be passively collected (that is, gathered without you actively providing the information) using various technologies and means, such as navigational data collection. Like most web site operators, we track IP addresses, assign Internet tags, and use both session and persistent cookies. We use cookies to help identify you when you visit our website and deliver content specific to your interests. You should be aware that we may use these cookies for other purposes now and in the future. Our system also automatically gathers information about the areas you visit on this website and collects operational information about the technology you use, such as the website that referred you to us and your browser, screen name, type of computer, operating systems and Internet service providers.

We passively collect information to generate statistics and measure site activity in order to understand what areas of this website most popular, which areas may require improvement and what technologies are being used by our visitors. This information helps us to update and improve this website and enhance the usefulness of customer visits. We also use this information for security purposes, to detect and to block security breaches and to provide you with a safe online environment.

HOW CELESTE USES YOUR INFORMATION

Celeste uses your personal information to enhance the operation of this website, allow you to use all of its features and provide you with the services that you request (i.e., fulfilling orders, contacting purchasers to inform them of their order status, sending promotional information, enhancing our website and the operation of our website, for statistical purposes, etc.).

Celeste may send you information about its products and services and may contact you about new features or products in which it believes you may be interested. Celeste also may use your contact information for marketing and other purposes. We only use your personal data for marketing purposes if we have a legal basis (i.e. Consent, Contracts, Legitimate Interest, etc.) to do so.

Celeste also will disclose any information that it is required to disclose by law or by an appropriate government authority.

Legitimate interests

When we have a business or commercial reason of our own to use your information, this is called a 'legitimate interest'. We will tell you what that is, if we are going to rely on it as the reason for using your data. Even then, it must not unfairly go against your interests. These interests are:

- communicating with you in relation to any issues, complaints, or disputes;
- improving the quality of experience when you interact with our products and/or services, including testing the performance of our products and customer experience of our website;
- developing, improving, and delivering marketing and advertising for products and services offered by Celeste.

WHO DO WE SHARE YOUR PERSONAL DATA WITH?

We will only share personal data with others when we have a legitimate reason to do so. When we share data with others, we put contractual arrangements and security mechanisms in place to protect the data and to comply with our GDPR, confidentiality and security standards.

We may share your personal information with the following categories of recipients:

- our group companies, third party services providers and partners who provide data processing services to us (for example, to support the delivery of, provide functionality on, or help to enhance the security of our website/application), or who otherwise process personal information for purposes that are described in this Privacy Notice or notified to you when we collect your personal information.
- Any competent law enforcement body, regulatory, government agency, court or other third party where we believe disclosure is necessary (i) as a matter of applicable law or regulation, (ii) to exercise, establish or defend our legal rights, or (iii) to protect your vital interests or those of any other person;
- A potential buyer (and its agents and advisers) in connection with any proposed purchase, merger or acquisition of any part of our business, provided that we inform the buyer it must use your personal information only for the purposes disclosed in this Privacy Notice;
- Any other person with your consent to the disclosure.

INDIVIDUAL RIGHTS AND HOW TO EXCERSISE THEM

Individuals have certain rights over their personal data and data controllers are responsible for fulfilling these rights. Where we decide how and why personal data is processed, we are a data controller and include further information about the rights that individuals have and how to exercise them below.

Right to Access

You have a right of access to personal data held by us as a data controller. This right may be exercised by emailing us at <u>customerservice@celestecorp.com</u>. We will aim to respond to any requests for information promptly, and in any event within the legally required time limits (within one month).

Right to Rectification

To update personal data submitted to us, you may email us at <u>customerservice@celestecorp.com</u>. When practically possible, once we are informed that any personal data processed by us is no longer accurate, we will make corrections (where appropriate) based on your updated information.

Right to Erasure

You have the right to request the deletion of your personal data where, for example, the personal data are no longer necessary for the purposes for which they were collected, where you withdraw your consent to processing, where there is no overriding legitimate interest for us to continue to process your personal data, or your personal data has been unlawfully processed. This opt out does not apply to information provided to Celeste as a result of a product purchase, warranty registration, product service experience or other transactions

Right to Object

In certain circumstances, you have the right to object to the processing of your personal data where, for example, your personal data is being processed on the basis of legitimate interests and there is no overriding legitimate interest for us to continue to process your personal data, or if your data is being processed for marketing purposes. Right to Restrict Processing

In certain circumstances, you have the right to request that we restrict the further processing of your personal data. We take reasonable steps to protect your personal data from loss or destruction. We also have procedures in place to deal with any suspected data security breach. We will notify you and any applicable regulator of a suspected data security breach where we are legally required to do so.

The secure server encrypts all sensitive information you input before it is sent to us. We use both technical and procedural methods to maintain the integrity and security of our databases, including but not limited to encryption for data transfer, firewalls, restricted access to data, employee training, and other methods.

RETENTION OF PERSONAL INFORMATION

Celeste retains the personal information collected on the website, directly from customers, suppliers or distributors as long as necessary to provide the services, products and information you request or as permitted by applicable law.

Complaints
